



# Case Management Services

## Healing and Achieving Picking up the pieces in everyday lives of survivors.

Case Managers provide consultation, advocacy and referral assistance to sexual assault survivors. A case manager's assistance to a survivor may range from brief consultation on housing and financial loss related issues to comprehensive support and advocacy on disability, unemployment, health insurance, and other issues that might impact a survivor's economic stability. The case management program also serves as the intake department of CRCC.

### ***Case Managers will help clients:***

- Make decisions about staying at a job or considering applying for disability benefits.
- Deal with housing questions.
- Receive ongoing mental health treatment and long term therapy.
- Pursue life goals delayed by aftermath of assault or new goals realized during treatment.
- Locate and utilize community resources and information for various life transitions/needs.



It is estimated that one out of three women and one out of six men are survivors of sexual violence. The CRCC helps survivors recover and grow strong. Our vision is the elimination of sexual violence. But, as long as this crime persists, we will continue to serve survivors and equip the community with vital tools to help address rape and sexual assault.
